Seeking the Lost like Jesus Did

In continuing to focus on Imitating Him, I call your attention to Jesus going to Zacchaeus’ house. (Luke 19:1-10) Zacchaeus was a chief tax collector in his day. Tax collectors were known for being greedy collecting more tax than was required. He’s described as rich in the text, most likely having become rich by dishonest gain. When Jesus noticed Zacchaeus’ efforts to see Him as He was passing by, Jesus called out to him to come down because he wanted to go with Zacchaeus to his house. Those who witnessed Jesus doing this accused Him of going to be a guest of a sinner. Then we learn from Jesus that this is why He came. “For the Son of Man has come to seek and to save that which was lost.” (Luke 19:10) This is what Jesus did. He spent time with sinners to bring them to salvation. “Today salvation has come to this house ...” (Luke 19:9)

As we each go forth this week, may we strive to Imitate Jesus in seeking and saving the lost remembering that in order to do so, we must spend time with sinners. In spending time with sinners, may we let God use us to lead them to Jesus and salvation found in Him. God bless you. I love you.
