Next month, on December 13th, eight more students will complete their second year of studies through South Chimbu Bible School. I have been invited to teach in the last session of their school year next year in December of 2010. Lord willing, I will be able to do this. If you would like to join me in this mission effort, begin praying about it now and let me know of your interest. With God all things are possible!

As we continue on in this period of Thanksgiving in our nation, let us all pause and thank God for all blessings, especially the way He always provides the increase as He promised He would as we plant and water the seed of His word in the hearts and lives of people. (1 Cor. 3:5-7) As we each go through the week ahead, may we keep on striving to let our light shine to the glory of our Father in heaven through the good works we are involved in. God bless you.
