### *Growing Spiritually from the Life of David*

David calls out to God in prayer during a great time of difficulty and distress in his life in Psalm 4. Take a moment and read his prayer to God for deliverance on this occasion. The setting is thought to be when David was forced to leave Jerusalem during the rebellion led by his son Absalom. (2 Samuel 15 – 17)

David responded to this very difficult time in his life in a very positive way. In verse 1, he found relief from God in his distress as he called out to God for help. He then expressed his confidence that God would hear him at the close of verse 3. David continued to worship God putting his trust fully in the Lord knowing that the Lord alone had the power to keep him safe. (4:5, 8)

On another occasion David spoke of how the troubles of his heart had been enlarged. However at this time, David again kept his trust in God knowing that God had the power to bring him out of his distress, affliction, and pain. He waited on the Lord to deliver him. (Psalm 25:16-22)

David learned that through his trials and difficulties spiritual growth occurred. If he had rebelled against God during his distress, he would have been torn down spiritually. Like David may we submit to God crying out to Him in prayer during distressing times trusting in Him to strengthen and protect us. When we do, we too will be built up and made stronger spiritually as David was. Instead of resenting trials surrender to the Lord, seek His help, and allow trials in your life to enlarge you spiritually.

Through the week ahead continue to strive to let your light shine before others to the Father's glory. Keep trusting in the Lord and His precious truth. God bless you. I love you.
