PRAYER

What do you think is the most important part of prayer? I really had not considered this question in any depth, because I've always considered all parts of our prayers equally important. However this week I read this following quote from George Mueller, who was considered a great man of faith. He was asked what he felt was the most important part of prayer, to which he replied, "The 15 minutes after I have said 'Amen.'"

You see no matter how great or meaningful our prayer might be; it's whether our faith is seen in what we do after we pray that really matters.

We had a little dog, Mandy that loved my wife and me with all of her heart. She sometimes "talked" to us (in her way of whining and staring) to let us know she wanted something, maybe wanting to go outside. We would say, "Ok, let's go." and she would take "off like a shot". She never hesitated, but took off at full speed to do whatever it was. She loved us and acted in faith that we meant what we said.

Jesus said, "The prayer of faith can accomplish much (move mountains)" Matthew 17:20. Yet, James tells us that, "faith without actions (works), is useless" James 2:17. In other words, you may be great at praying, but that is not enough. You may say all of the right words and include all of the proper phrases you have heard others use, but that is not enough. It is what you do after you end the prayer that matters most.

So, let me encourage you to start living like you believe God hears your prayers. Begin walking with faith and courage in this world that tries to tell you that there is no God. After all, if we believe God's word, we have to include the part that say, "Faith without works is a dead faith." Live like you believe, not just in God, but in what he says also!
